State Testing Infor- mation:

State Testing will begin on 4/9/18 starting with 4th grade.

- 4th grade will begin-
ning April 9th
through April 13th.
- 5th grade will test
beginning April 16th
through April 20th.
- 3rd grade will test
beginning April 23th
through April 27th.

These test are used to measure student achievement and tell schools which skill students need to improve. With this information the school can design a lesson to raise your child's academic performance. So, it is important to all involved, that every child do well on tests. Students need to be here on time for testing.

How can parents help?

Most of the test will be done in the morning. **Attendance makes a difference!**

- Make sure your child is in school everyday.
- Don't schedule any medical appointments during this time.
- Don't allow your child to be tardy.
